FOOD FOR THOUGHT

Poverty in Hong Kong x community visit

Do you know how much people living in poverty spend on food every day? This workshop will encourage participants to explore the relationship between poverty and food through a tour at a wet market.

FOOD RESCUE IN SHEK KIP MEI

Sustanible food x community service

Over 1/3 of all food produced globally goes to waste. In a developed city like Hong Kong, the issue of food waste is often taken lightly while many low-income families struggle hard to feed themselves. In this workshop, participants will have hands-on experience rescuing and redistributing food to the elderly in need in Shek Kip Mei and further explore the link between food waste and poverty.

Location: Shek Kip Mei

Duration: 3 hours, fixed time from 6 - 9 pm

A CLOUD ON THE HORIZON

Climate change x interactive theatre

Through imagination and body languages, participants will step into the role of the citizen of the Beautiful Island. Due to climate change, this island face the issue of rising of sea level. The citizen need to decide whether they stay or not. In this workshop, participants will explore the link between climate change and poverty.

Location: Oxfam Hong Kong's Interactive Education Centre (North Point) Duration: 2 hours (senior primary school), 2.5 hours (secondary school) This activity is co-organised with our partner DUO Production.



Ranging from 15 - 45 mins, we offer talks to schools, organisations or groups that have 30 participants or above.
